



Comite Drive Road Closure

Foster Drive to Pettit Road

Residential Access Information

Beginning Tuesday, June 1st at 12:00 a.m., workers plan to close Comite Drive from Foster Drive to Pettit Road for construction as part of a Green Light Plan project to widen the roadway.

The roadway will be closed for a period of nine (9) months, weather permitting, for the installation of the new 125-foot bridge at Whites Bayou, the installation of the new public sewer system and the replacement of existing roadway. The construction company will be working overtime to expedite construction during the roadway closure.

Residential Services

In preparation of the road closure, the following entities have been notified to ensure residential services will remain in place.

Trash Collection: Trash and Waste Removal will remain in place and on the current scheduled service day.

Mail and Package Delivery: Mail and Package Delivery will remain in place with the US Postal Service. FedEx and UPS Deliveries will be permitted through the road closure for deliveries to the residents.

School Bus Routes: Local schools will be notified of the road closure and access will be provided to school buses who service the residents within the road closure limits.

Emergency Services: Every effort will be made to ensure emergency services remain in place for the residents within the road closure limits.

Sanitary Sewer Information

The Comite Drive roadway project includes the installation of a public sanitary sewer collection system. This new line will collect sanitary sewer from many of the residents along Comite Drive between Plank Road and Cline Drive. When the installation of the sewer line is complete, the Department of Public works will provide each resident with information explaining what steps are needed to properly connect the existing house treatment system to the new sewer line.
